

PRESIDING BISHOP'S EPISTLE

Praised be Jesus Christ!

Dearly beloved in the Lord, 2024 has thus far been another glorious and invigorating year of grace and salvation for our Province and the Diocese of the Eastern United States, and I am delighted to submit this seventh Presiding Bishop's Epistle in advance of the Eastern US Diocesan Synod, which is to occur next month, the 56th in our progressing and graced history. In this Epistle, I shall endeavour to share some highlights of episcopal activities over the past six months leading up to our time together in Greensboro, North Carolina.

On 7th January, after a day's delay because of snow and ice, we celebrated the Mass of Institution of the Reverend Father Sean McDermott as the new Rector of All Saints' Church in Charlottesville, Virginia. Please pray for Father Sean, his wife Julie, and their children, as they embark on this new and exciting adventure. We offer our deepest thanks to Canon Glenn Spencer, his wife Ann, and their family for the loving and exceptional ministry they provided All Saints' for 32 years.

It was terrific to return to Saint Matthew's Church, Weaverville, North Carolina on $14^{\rm th}$ January for an annual visitation. From $17^{\rm th}$ to $18^{\rm th}$ January I participated in the Anglican Joint Synods – Polish National Catholic Church Dialogue Meeting on Zoom.

On the weekend of 20th and 21st January, I was profoundly privileged to make my first episcopal visitation as Bishop Ordinary to Saint Mark's Church, Vero Beach, Florida.

From 22nd to 25th January, Canon Wade Miller and I sojourned on a mission trip to the Deep South, Mississippi, Louisiana, and Texas, for the purpose of assisting in the organisation of the newest APA congregation, Saint Columba's Church, Shreveport, Louisiana, which is now fully organised and operational. Deacon Jason McInnis, formerly of the Reformed Episcopal Church, leads the faithful of Saint Columba's and is soon to be received into our Province and

Diocese, God willing. We are absolutely delighted to welcome Deacon McInnis and the people of Saint Columba's into our Church. We beg your prayers for the work and mission of our newest local Church, the farthest west in the Eastern US Diocese.

It was a spectacular treat to make my first official visitation as Bishop Ordinary to Saint Alban's Cathedral, Oviedo, Florida, from 9th to 11th February. On that auspicious occasion, I was privileged to declare Bishop Walter Grundorf as Presiding Bishop Emeritus of the APA and Bishop Emeritus of DEUS. On 17th and 18th February, I was thrilled to return to All Saints' Parish, Wilmington, North Carolina, for the annual visit.

An almost unique experience occurred on the weekend of 24th and 25th February, when I was blessed beyond measure to make an episcopal visitation to All Souls' Church, Asheboro, North Carolina, and to receive Saint Andrew's Church (formerly of the Reformed Episcopal Church) into All Souls' and APA Church membership. In this fantastic development, two Anglican mission Churches have now united and become one, under our jurisdiction. Father Michael Sclafani, the supply priest of All Souls', is surely the architect of this achievement and is to be tremendously commended for his ministry.

I was truly honoured to visit Saint Philip's Church, Blacksburg, Virginia on 2nd and 3rd March and Saint Patrick's Church, Brevard, North Carolina on 9th and 10th March.

During the week of 12th to 15th March, Dean Matthew Harlow, Father Scott Greene, and I made an official visit to Nashotah House Theological Seminary, Nashotah, Wisconsin on behalf of the APA, my first visit. I was invited to preach before the Seminary, to attend worship, meals, and classes, and to enjoy the accommodations of 'Lambeth West' once occupied by Archbishop Michael Ramsey. It was an extraordinary and illuminating visit. I was certainly impressed.

On 12th March, another first in Continuing Church history, a milestone event, transpired. I was asked to ordain the Reverend Johnny Lawrence III to the Sacred Order of Deacons on behalf of the Diocese of the Holy Cross of the Anglican Catholic Church and Bishop Paul Hewett at Holy Apostles Church, Pewaukee, Wisconsin, a parish of the Anglican Church in America. APA, ACC, and ACA acting as one. The Ordination was a most encouraging sign of the unity and collaboration of the Anglican Joint Synods.

The week of 8th to 11th April, beginning with a transfixing eclipse of the sun, saw the annual APA Spring Clergy Retreat in beautiful Helen, Georgia. The time of prayer, food, fellowship, and fun was unparalleled. The theme, 'G1? - Ecclesial Communion in Continuing Anglicanism and Ecumenical Prospects for the Future,' explored the present and future of the Anglican Joint Synods Communion and the efforts to cultivate a closer unity and cooperation. A frank and transparent discussion emerged amongst the clergy assembled. We were privileged to have the Rt. Rev. Markus Dogo from the Church of Nigeria join us. Bishop Dogo spoke about the formation process of training clergy in Nigeria and the hard work required of them to establish successful missions in the country.

The exquisite newly-renovated chapel of Saint James-on-the-Glebe Church, Gloucester, Virginia was consecrated to Almighty God with the full traditional rite on 13th April. The new space, constructed entirely by the faithful, is breathtaking in its beauty and elegance. A deeply-moving episcopal visitation followed the next day. Our Lord is accomplishing wonders on the Glebe.

It should be noted that from 9th April to 23rd April, Bishop David Haines and Dean Paul Rivard journeyed to the Philippines on a remarkable mission trip. Multiple Masses were celebrated, including the Ordination of Deacon Ryan Egipto and the Ordination of the Reverend Fathers Agustin Agos, Edel Amarante, Seth Galpo, and Salvador Miaque. Numerous Baptisms (16) and Confirmations (26) were administered. The Consecration of Saint Andrew the Apostle Church in Barangay Tubili, Paluan, Mindoro Occidental was followed by the blessing of the offices and clergy living quarters. The Consecration of Saint James the Great Church

took place in Bauang, La Union, Luzon. An episcopal visitation and Mass occurred at Saint Francis Church, Lower Baratao, in Baung, La Union, Luzon. Please pray for our Church in the Philippines.

With a sense of great gratitude for and inspiration from our faithful, my episcopal visitations continued at Saint Paul's Church, Melbourne, Florida from 26th to 28th April, Saint Paul's Church, Crownsville, Maryland from 8th to 12th May, Holy Spirit Church, Hatfield, Pennsylvania (a first ever visit) from 18th to 19th May, Saint George the Martyr Church, Simpsonville, South Carolina on 26th May, and Saint Matthias Church, Dothan, Alabama on 5th June. Please remember that Saint Matthias Dothan welcomes the assistance of supply clergy for Sunday Mass. Please also pray for Father Stephen Miller, his wife Jennifer, and their children, as Father Steve begins his new ministry as assistant at Holy Trinity Church and Lindisfarne Hall, Fernandina Beach, Florida under Father Bradley Cunningham.

Holy Mother Church exults in the Ordination of the Reverend Father Ian Patrick Jarrells to the Sacred Order of Priests, which occurred at Saint Thomas the Apostle Church, Alto, Georgia on 8th June. Thou art a Priest forever after the Order of Melchizedek! Father Ian is now officially the Vicar of Saint Thomas Alto. Let us pray for Father Ian and his wife Joy as they begin this new powerful stage in their ministry together.

Sunday 9th June witnessed the 45th anniversary of Saint Barnabas Cathedral, Atlanta, Georgia with Holy Mass, the blessing of new hymnals, and the consecration of a new icon of Saint Barnabas. An extremely well-attended reception luncheon followed the Mass and the recognition of special members who have contributed significantly to the life of our Cathedral Church over the years.

Just like old times, it was fabulous to visit the 2024 Anglican Summer Camp in Westfield, North Carolina on 13th June, to celebrate Solemn High Mass, and to revel in the traditional 'stump the Bishop' catechetical time with the children. We earnestly thank Dean Matthew Harlow for his many years of dedicated service as our camp director; he retired from that role at the end of camp this year. And we thank Father Sean McDermott for his willingness to assume this ministry. We can never exhaust our support for Anglican Summer Camp, the APA's sole jurisdiction-wide ministry for children. Please continue to be generous in prayer and financial support.

Upcoming events include: the celebration of the wedding of Father Randall Russell and Lisa Becksford at Saint Philip's Church, Blacksburg, Virginia on 20th July; an episcopal visitation and Confirmations at Saint Philip's Blacksburg on 21st July; our 56th Synod of the Diocese of the Eastern United States, Greensboro, North Carolina from 29th July to 2nd August; an episcopal visitation and Confirmations at Christ the Redeemer Church, Warner Robins, Georgia on 4th August; the Anglican Joint Synods-Polish National Catholic Church Dialogue Meeting at All Saints' Cathedral (PNCC) in Chicago, Illinois from 12th to 14th August; and on 18th August, an episcopal visitation and Confirmations, Saint James-on-the-Glebe Church, Gloucester, Virginia.

Diocesan Synod is coming very soon! Please remember that DEUS Synod registration and hotel reservation deadlines arrive on Friday 28^{th} June. All clergy and lay delegates and alternates need to be registered for Synod and have hotel rooms reserved. After the deadline, Synod registrations incur a late fee of \$25. Synod registrations will be completely closed two weeks before the event itself. Synod is our annual family reunion and the most important meeting of its kind every year. Please be sure to join us and to offer intercessory prayer for the labour and business of the Synod.
